Conference strengths (1)

Conference weaknesses (2)

- English speakers talk too fast
- Very advanced for EBHC beginners
- Screening / filtering of abstracts
- Some confusion about the schedule
- Too short
- Too much food
- No Internet
- Location difficult to reach
